

ST. SAVA CAMP INSTRUCTIONS

Camp check-in: Sunday 2:00 p.m.-4:30 p.m. (NOT earlier!)
Camp check-out: Saturday 9:00 a.m.- 11:00 am (NOT later!)

The camping experience at St. Sava Camp offers the camper a wide variety of activities that fill the week's schedule. Campers attend matins and vesper services, and participate in classes in religious education, Serbian culture, music and folklore. Additional activities include field trips, arts and crafts, games, swimming and other sports. Please read carefully and conform to the following instructions in order that your child is properly prepared for a week at St. Sava Camp:

DRESS CODE: While camping is informal, church camp imposes obvious restrictions that must be taken into account when packing for camp. **Any camper wearing clothing deemed inappropriate by the Camp Clergy or Coordinator will be refused participation in camp activities until the camper is properly dressed. Should a camper or staffer refuse to adhere to the St. Sava Camp dress code, they will be sent home.** Please use the following checklist to ensure your child packs the appropriate items for his/her camp week:

ITEMS TO BRING

- For Church Services: Long dress pants and polo or other nice shirt for men/boys. Women/girls must wear a dress or skirt (knee-length or longer), shirt, and a head covering
- Jeans, shorts (shorts above mid-thigh are **unacceptable**, no writing on the back side of shorts or pants)
- T-Shirts (halter, exposed midriff, cut-off sleeve and spaghetti-strap shirts are **unacceptable**)
- Gym shoes, sturdy walking shoes, beach/shower sandals
- Underwear and socks
- Modest ONE-PIECE swimsuit (Failure to wear will result in exclusion from camp activity)**
- Sweatshirt or sweater
- Pajamas and bathrobe
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Pillow, sheet, pillowcase and blanket and/or sleeping bag
- Dirty clothes bag, towels, washcloth and beach towel
- Insect repellent and sunscreen (no aerosols, please)
- Toiletries: Comb, hairbrush, toothbrush and paste, soap, shampoo, deodorant, etc.
- Musical instrument, sheet music, CD, poem for recitation for Talent Show Use Only

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED AT CAMP

- ◆ Cell phones (including camera phones)
- ◆ Immodest apparel (no inappropriate wording or graphics on clothing)
- ◆ No electronic media: (games, televisions, stereos, CD players, MP3s, iPods, etc)
- ◆ Shaving cream, silly string
- ◆ Illegal substances (alcohol, drugs, tobacco)
- ◆ Dangerous implements (fireworks, weapons)
- ◆ Jewelry and any other valuables you'd rather not see lost.
- ◆ Snacks, candy or beverages

If any items on the above list are brought and found by camp personnel, they will be taken away and may result in immediate dismissal.

CELL PHONES AND CAR KEYS MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE OFFICE AT CHECK IN TIME!

MEDICATION: If your child is receiving medication, please note on the Camper Health Form. No medications are to be kept by the campers or in their room. Upon arrival at camp, your child will be required to submit his/her medication to the Camp Personnel, who will ensure that they are dispensed at the proper times in the correct dosages. Please include any special written instructions with the medication that will be forwarded to the Camp Nurse.

ST. SAVA CAMP ACTIVITIES: All campers will participate in camp activities unless otherwise stated by a physician.

TELEPHONE CALLS: Unless there is an emergency, telephone calls are not allowed to or from campers. **Please be assured that you will be contacted immediately in the event of an emergency.**
